- 1. Health and safety shall be of prime importance at Lake-Sumter State College and shall take precedence over any rule, procedure, job, task or program.
- 2. To support this rule and to ensure that all employment and places of employment are free of recognizable workplace and environmental hazards, the President shall develop and implement a comprehensive safety and health program consisting, as a minimum, of the following elements:
 - a. Safety rule for employees and students (Safety Manual)
 - b. A disaster/evacuation plan (Emergency Response Manual)
 - c. Safety inspections
 - d. A preventative maintenance program
 - e. A safety and health training program for employees
 - f. A first aid program
 - g. Accident, incident and injury/death investigation and reporting procedures
 - h. Appropriate record keeping.
