REFERS TO PROCEDURE NUMBER: PRO 7-02 and 7-03

1. Health and safety shall be of prime importance at Lake-Sumter State College and shall take precedence over any rule, procedure, job, task or program.
2. To support this rule and to ensure that all employment and places of employment are free of recognizable workplace and environmental hazards, the President shall develop and implement a comprehensive safety and health program consisting, as a minimum, of the following elements:
 - a. Safety rule for employees and students (Safety Manual)
 - b. A disaster/evacuation plan (Emergency Response Manual)
 - c. Safety inspections
 - d. A preventative maintenance program
 - e. A safety and health training program for employees
 - f. A first aid program
 - g. Accident, incident and injury/death investigation and reporting procedures
 - h. Appropriate record keeping.
