1. For purposes of this rule, alcoholic beverages shall be defined as wine, beer, wine coolers, distilled spirits, or any other beverage which contains alcohol.
2. The sale, possession, serving or consumption of alcoholic beverages on College property or at College-sponsored student-oriented functions are prohibited.
3. Certain exceptions to this rule may be authorized as follows:
 - a. The President may waive this rule in writing, on special occasions and on a case by case basis, with regard to the serving of wine or beer on College property by organizations or individuals;
 - b. The District Board may waive this rule on special occasions and on a case by case basis, with regard to the serving of all other forms of alcoholic beverages on College property by organizations or individuals.
4. These exceptions shall not be interpreted as modification or relaxation of standards of conduct for students or staff relative to alcoholic beverages as set forth in this rule.
