1. It is the policy of the District Board to require acceptable academic performance from students enrolled at the College.
2. The President or designee shall establish procedures that define the academic standard for good standing, probation, or suspension status for all students. These procedures shall also include specific standards of academic progress for students receiving financial aid and for those participating in student activities.
3. The College Standards of Academic Progress serve two purposes:
 - a. To provide a vehicle for the early identification of students who are experiencing academic difficulty, and
 - b. To make available a process for providing as much assistance as possible to those students to facilitate their success in achieving their educational goals.
