- 1. The intercollegiate athletic program is established to supplement the total educational experience of its students.
- 2. The College adheres to regulations established by the National Junior College Athletic Association, the Florida Community College Activities Association, the rules of the State Board of Education, the Florida Statutes, and the rules of the District Board of Trustees as they relate to the conduct of student athletes, the administration and financial control of the athletic program, and the development of a gender equity plan that includes consideration of equity in sports offerings, participation, availability of facilities, scholarship offerings, and funds allocated for administration, recruitment, comparable coaching, publicity and promotion, and other support costs.
- 3. Student-athletes must comply with all rules relating to admission, financial aid, academic standards, and program completion.
- 4. The College may sponsor intramural sports activities.
- 5. The President is the official responsible for certifying that the Community College is in compliance with the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA), the Florida Community College Activities Association (FCCAA), and the Mid-Florida Conference rules and regulations.

The President is authorized to develop procedures for directing the intercollegiate athletic program including review of athletic policies and procedures, budget, personnel, recruitment, admission, financial aid, and continuing eligibility.
