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The President may authorize the use of Lake-Sumter State College facilities as an assembly area, emergency evacuation point and/or emergency shelter in support of community disaster plans. All such use shall be coordinated with the appropriate emergency management agency and shall be formalized by written agreement to include.

Agreement that the user shall assume all financial responsibility for any auxiliary equipment needed, or for any damage to College property incurred as a result of the use of the facility/ equipment.

Agreement that the user shall, to the fullest extent permitted by law, defend, indemnify and hold harmless the District Board of Trustees, Lake-Sumter State College, and its officers, agents, staff members and employees from all actions, claims and demands whatsoever that may be asserted by, or on behalf of, anyone against the College, its officers, agents, staff members and employees because, or as a result of, any accident, bodily injury or illness that may occur to, or be sustained by, any person, agency or company that arises out of the activities conducted in conjunction with this use by the user, their employees, or anyone acting on their behalf.
