## DUAL ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST

Dual Enrollment Eligibility Requirements:

- Un-weighted 3.0 high school GPA
- Complete at least two (2) high school-level classes with a passing grade (HOPE credit not eligible)
- Qualifying Test scores
  - SAT: Reading 24, Writing 25, Mathematics 24
  - o ACT: Reading 19, English 17, and Math 19
  - o PERT: Reading 106, English 103, Math 114
  - o CLT: Reading and Writing 38 combined, Math 16
- Submit by Dual Enrollment Deadline published on <u>Early College Programs Webpage</u> (Issc.edu/ecp) Test scores must be less than two years old and may be mixed for eligibility purposes.
  - ☐ 1. Complete <u>placement testing</u> (*libguides.lssc.edu/testcenter*), meeting the minimum scores listed above.
  - ☐ 2. Submit the <u>Dual Enrollment Application</u>, providing the following supporting documentation:
    - a. GPA and 2 HS-class Verification through Transcript (Public, Private, and Charter school students)
    - b. Proof of Qualifying Test Scores (All students)
    - c. Proof of alternative credit such as AP or IB, if applicable (All students)
    - d. Home Education Verification Form (Home Education students only)
    - e. Signed Dual Enrollment Home Education Agreement (Home Education students only)
  - ☐ 3. Check email in 5-7 business days for an LSSC Acceptance Letter that provides next steps.
  - ☐ 4. Once accepted, log into your LakeHawk account and LSSC email as instructed in the acceptance letter.
  - □ 5. Schedule your New Student Advising and Registration (NSAR) Orientation using the link in your LSSC email.
  - ☐ 6. Once Orientation is complete and your hold is removed, you may register for classes before the deadline.

    <u>Classes are not finalized until School Counselor and LSSC DE Advisor approve courses.</u>
  - 7. Students should arrange to pick up textbooks and supplies for classes.
    - a. Public School Students- Lake County
      - i. Lake County Textbook pick-up location: 509 S. Palm Ave. Howey-in-the-Hills
      - ii. Contact Lake County Schools at 352-253-6770 with any questions.
    - b. Public School Students- Sumter County
      - i. Textbook/materials are delivered to the respective high schools (South Sumter/Wildwood). The guidance counselor will then distribute materials to students.
      - ii. Contact Sumter County Schools at 352-793-5719 with any questions.
    - c. Private School Students
      - i. Textbooks are obtained at the LSSC Leesburg Campus and South Lake Campus bookstores.
    - d. Home Education Students
      - i. Textbooks are obtained at the LSSC Leesburg Campus and South Lake Campus bookstores.
    - e. Charter School Students
      - i. Please speak to your counselor for textbook pickup instructions as they vary by school.
