



## **A.S. Nursing Program Pre-Application Testing**

The Lake-Sumter State college Associate in Science of Nursing program now accepts both the HESI and TEAS exams. You may meet the requirement with exams completed at the LSSC Testing Centers, or you may order transcripts through Elsevier Inc. (HESI) or ATI (TEAS) for exams completed elsewhere.

Eligible scores for each exam are included with your application to the limited access A.S. Nursing program, and the highest scores for each test/ subject are used for your application.

<b>LSSC Required Sections</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Math (approximately 50 questions)</li><li>• Reading comprehension (approximately 50 questions)</li><li>• Grammar (approximately 50 questions)</li><li>• Vocabulary (approximately 50 questions)</li></ul>	Complete the entire exam
<b>Testing Parameters</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Maximum testing time of 3.5 hours (you decide how much time to spend on each section)</li><li>• Re-testing; student chooses sections; 1 hour per section not to exceed 3 hours total</li><li>• 30-day wait for re-testing</li><li>• Maximum of 3 testing attempts per calendar year</li><li>• No maximum on number of attempts over time</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Maximum testing time of 3.5 hours- exam timer drives progression through sections</li><li>• Complete the entire exam at every testing attempt</li><li>• 30-day wait for re-testing</li><li>• Maximum of 3 testing attempts per calendar year</li><li>• No maximum on number of attempts over time</li></ul>
