UCF Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences

Health Sciences majors build a strong foundation in the scientific study of human health and prepare for careers in medicine, health professions, research, health promotion, and public health.

The **Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences** at **University of Central Florida** offers two tracks: **Pre-Clinical** and **Health Promotion**, allowing students to choose a path that supports their career goals with guidance from a faculty advisor.

The **Pre-Clinical Track** prepares students for careers such as physician, physician assistant, dentist, or pharmacist. The **Health Promotion Track** prepares students for roles like physical therapist, occupational therapist, health researcher, or public health specialist.
